This may be an NLIS approved electronic identification (eID) - ear tag or leg band. The device may not be physically attached to the goats, but it must accompany them to be scanned at their destination.
3. For movements off property, the goats must be accompanied by the permit, the NLIS devices (worn as a collar) and a correctly completed movement document such as the National Vendor Declaration (NVD) or Tasmanian Generic Vendor Declaration (GVD).

Privacy Statement

1. Purpose of Collection

The information collected in this application is being collected for the purposes of assessing, in accordance with the *Biosecurity (Livestock Traceability) Regulations 2024*, the applicant's eligibility to be issued a permit to dispatch goats without a permanent identification device attached and for the maintenance of the department's livestock property database. The information may also be used to track the movement of livestock by inclusion in the National Livestock Identification System (NLIS) Database.

2. Disclosure of Personal Information

Personal information collected may be communicated to Meat and Livestock Australia and recorded in the NLIS Database. Personal information in the NLIS database including your name, email address, telephone number, PIC number and property address may be accessed by parties approved by Meat and Livestock Australia to access the NLIS Database. Your personal information may also be provided to third parties where required by law and your basic personal information may be disclosed to another public sector body if it is necessary to do so for its efficient storage or use. Personal information will be managed in accordance with the *Personal Information Protection Act 2004* and may be accessed by the individual to whom it relates on request to NRE Tas.

3. Result of Failure to Provide Personal information

If you do not provide any personal information requested in this application form your permit to dispatch goats without a permanent identification device attached may not be processed.

4. Accessing Personal information

A person may request access to personal information collected by the Department of Natural Resources and Environment Tasmania and may be charged a fee for this service.
